Question 5:

4: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36

6: 6, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, 48, 54

Question 6:

15: 15, 30, 45, 60, 75, 90, 105, 120, 135

12: 12, 24, 36, 48, 60, 72, 84, 96, 108

The Least Common Multiple (LCM) of 15 and 12 is 60.
